2. Program C (March-May Application):1st Cycle from March 1st to March 23rd
3. Program C (March-May Application):2nd Cycle from Apr. 25th to May 28th

We are pleased to announce the instructions on how to apply for the Super Short-Term Programs (SSTP or Program C) to be offered by member institutions of UMAP in 2019!

Please promote the programs which are available on UMAP Student Connection Online (USCO) System (<https://usco.umap.org/>).

There are three cut-off dates for the student application period as shown below;

1. Program C (January Application) 1st Cycle from Jan. 12th to Jan. 23rd
2. Program C (March-May Application) 1st Cycle from March 1st to March 23rd
3. Program C (March-May Application) 2nd Cycle from Apr. 25th to May 28th

To apply, the following three steps must be completed by each deadline.

- **REGISTRATION** – Students create an account on the USCO System by registering their email address and password (<https://usco.umap.org/std/>). For more information about the USCO System, students can check the Student User Manual through this link (<http://umap.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/10/UMAP-Student-Connection-Online-USCO-Manual-for-Students.pdf>).
- **APPLICATION** – Students must complete the Application Form in the USCO System for up to three preferred programs and click “Save and Submit”. The USCO System will automatically inform the UMAP coordinators at the home university/institution that an application has been submitted. Applications will be accepted based on each Timeline.
- **NOMINATION** -- Coordinators log into the USCO System (<https://usco.umap.org/incw/>), using the ID and password previously sent by UMAP IS. They can then check the applications they have received, and nominate appropriate students by clicking “Approve”.

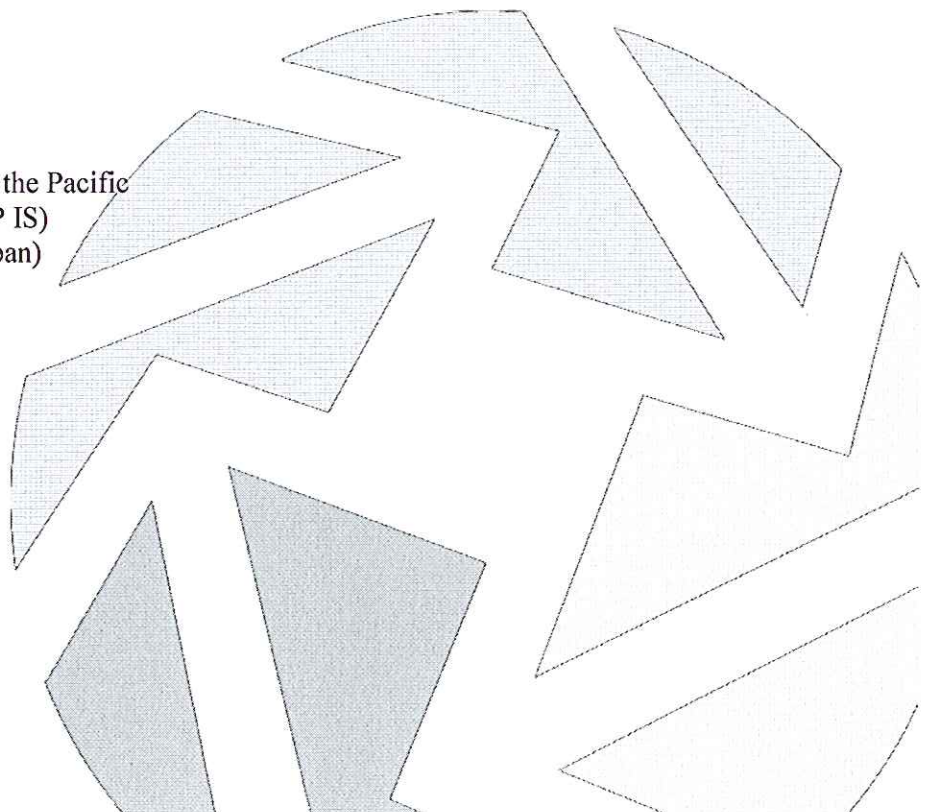
