1. Personal Data Form

This is an online form in our application system containing your personal details (name, address, academic history, language proficiency, employment history, etc.). If you change your address after the application period is over, please make sure that you notify the IMBA Program office so we can contact you.

In the Employment History area, please include descriptions of your 3 most recent full-time post-baccalaureate positions.

2. Essays

The required Essays allow the Admissions Committee to learn about you, your accomplishments and your professional aspirations. You will be asked some questions and type them in the application system. Your essay should not be written or edited by anyone other than yourself. Please prepare these essays carefully and candidly, follow the instructions in the system for each essay.

Required Essays

- (1) Describe your short-term and long-term career goals and explain how your past experience together with an IMBA from the NCCU will contribute to your achieving them. (750 words maximum)
- (2) Answer any 2 questions from the 4 choices below:
 - A. Describe a time when you were part of a team in a professional environment that worked well. Also, describe a time when you were part of a team that did not work well. (500 words maximum)
 - B. Reflect on a time when your efforts resulted in a change within an organization. Please discuss your role in these changes. (500 words)
 - C. Describe a situation where you were able to use your leadership skills to create a better outcome. (500 words)
 - D. Discuss a risk you took that proved to be successful. Also describe a time when a risk you took was not successful. (500 words)

Optional Essay

Please include any other information that you believe would be helpful to the Admissions Committee in considering your application. (250 words maximum)

3. Two recommendation letters

Two recommendations are required and should be completed by individuals who are well acquainted with you and your managerial capabilities. Preferably, they should be completed by employers or supervisors. You are advised to request recommendations well in advance of the application deadline to ensure your application package is complete when submitted.

As part of the online application process you will be asked to provide email addresses for your recommenders; the system will then send them a link they can use to access the system and fill the recommendation letter online or upload a letter of their own.

- 4. Official transcripts from each college/university attended
- 5. A copy of most recent university/college diploma

We require one copy of your transcript and one copy of the diploma or other documentation indicating the date and conferral of your degree. If the original language of the academic record and diploma is not English or Chinese, a certified English translation must accompany original documents. Official copies of

credentials must be certified by a school administrative officer from whom the degree was received.

6. Evidence of English Proficiency

We ask all applicants to provide their Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score or other evidence of English proficiency (other test scores, i.e. IELTS, TOEIC, etc.) if their native language is not English.

If you hold a degree from an English speaking country or a program taught in English, you do not have to submit the evidence of English proficiency. Please mark the check box "I do not need an English Proficiency test score" in the online system.

7. Evidence of Management Study Aptitude

The Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) is not a requirement for admittance to the program. Applicants are however strongly advised to take the test and submit their scores as additional support to their application. GMAT is administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) in the USA as evidence of management aptitude. The GMAT can be forwarded through National Chengchi University's GMAT code 9993. Include a photocopy of the score report in your application package. For more information or to request that your scores be sent to us, contact the GMAT, Educational Testing Service, P.O. - 2. To cultivate professionals in international and cross-cultural management.



▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- * Applicants must meet the MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan. Eligibility Criteria for application to IHRD Program: Bachelor diploma.
- * Applicants holding certificate of equivalency exams is not eligible for application. Please note your application will not be accepted.
- * Due to the different education system in each country, an applicant who will graduate at the same year as the admission to National Taiwan Normal University must ensure to receive his/her diploma and academic transcript of the highest academic degree by the following deadlines

(Applicants applying with diplomas or degree certificates from China are required to have the documents notarized by relevant authorities. Only applicants who strictly follow this requirement are qualified to apply. Application Deadline (only for fall semester): March 30, 2019

Note 1. According to Article 2 of the Nationality Law, a person who meets one of the following requirements acquires the nationality of the Republic of China and therefore is disqualified for applying as an International Student:

- 1. A person whose father or mother is, at the time of his/her birth, a citizen of the Republic of China.*
- 2. A person born after the death of his/her father or mother, and whose parent was, at the time of death, a citizen of the Republic of China. *
- 3. A person born in the territory of the Republic of China and whose parents are both unknown or are stateless.
- 4. A naturalized citizen.
 - * An individual born on or before February 9th, 1980 needs only consider the nationality of his or her father.

Note 2. As stated in the Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan, "Overseas Chinese Students who have graduated; been expelled, or suspended from their studies for longer than the maximum allowable duration will lose their status as an Overseas Chinese Student. Students whose status has been temporarily suspended will resume their status upon returning to school." Anyone meeting one of the following requirements is considered Overseas Chinese, and therefore is disqualified for applying as an International Student:

- 1. Anyone having previously studied at the Division of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students at National Taiwan Normal University (formerly known as 'National University of Preparatory School for Overseas Chinese Students').
- 2. Anyone having applied for studies or previously studied in any school in Taiwan as an Overseas Chinese.
- 3. Anyone having taken the university entrance exam for Overseas Chinese students held by the 'University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Student' has filled out the choices of university/college and has been admitted to one of the universities/colleges.

- 2. Application Submission: Please apply online via our application website: http://ap.itc.ntnu.edu.tw/istudent/apply/. Only online application shall be accepted. Please first complete the online application, and upload all the relevant documents before the deadline. Hard copy applicants / documents will not be accepted. Late applications will not be accepted.

If authentication cannot be completed by the application deadline, please submit two copies of degree certificate, two copies of transcript and a signed Deposition of Admission Documents.
 - * Eligible applicants who graduate at the same year as the admission to National Taiwan Normal University must submit transcripts for each academic semester and the 'Deposition of Admission Documents for National Taiwan Normal University International Applicants', and are not required to submit the diploma during application. The diploma and transcripts for each academic semester must be submitted upon registration (foreign diplomas and transcripts must be verified by the ROC representative office in the country of the institution which issued the diplomas and transcripts; diplomas or degree certificates from China are required to have the documents notarized by relevant authorities.); otherwise, the applicants admitted to NTNU will have their admission revoked.






▲ ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- 1. This program includes four core courses (financial and cost concepts for engineering & construction, project schedule control, operation research, engineering information management) and 20+ courses in management and technical fields.
- 2. Graduation Credits: 36
 - (1) A minimum of 30 credits in coursework and 6 credits in master's thesis must be completed.
 - (2) Master students must fulfill a minimum of 36 credits consisting of at least 18 credits from our department.
- 3. Students will earn the "Master of Science" degree from the Department of Civil Engineering, College of Engineering after the full completion.

▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must qualify for legal student status in compliance with Article Two of the Ministry of Education's "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan".
- 2. Upon completion of the course of study, at a school in Taiwan, to which an international student has applied, the student's admission to higher academic levels shall be handled in a manner identical to the procedures of admission for local students, except that an application for master's degree or higher level of graduate studies can be processed under the rules of each individual school.
- 3. International students who withdraw from university/college after admission due to behavior issues, poor academic performance or a conviction under the Criminal Code may not thereafter apply again for admission under "MOE Regulation Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". If a student wishes to transfer from another university in Taiwan, he or she should still apply as a new student, and notify the original university according to their rules.
- 4. During the course of study in Taiwan, international students, who are approved for initial household registration, resident registration, naturalization or restoration of their ROC nationality, will lose their international student status and shall withdraw from school.
