- \*English or Chinese verified version is also necessary if the original diploma is not in either language. Both the original and verified translated transcripts shall be submitted within two weeks after school begins.
- \*Certificate of enrollment is required if applicants are currently studying in the last semester of school.
- 7. One photocopy of official English yearly transcripts with verification by the TAIWAN missions/ embassies/ representative offices in the country where the documents are issued.
  - \*English or Chinese verified version is also necessary if the original transcripts is not in either language. Both the original and verified translated transcripts shall be submitted within two weeks after school begins.
  - \*If applicants are studying in the last semester of school, required documents shall be verified after graduation.
- 8. Two letters of recommendation
  - \*Please save the file either JPEG or PDF format. References should sign on the letter, and position titles and contact information should also be provided. Recommendation letters shouldn't be written by friends or family members.
- 9. Evidence of English proficiency:
  - \*Applicants whose official national language is English are exempt from needing to supply these documents.
  - \*TOEFL paper test 500, TOEFL IBT 61, TOEFL CBT 173, IELTS 5.5 or TOEIC 550.



- 3. A minimum GPA of B or 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (a notarized Chinese or English translation of transcript is required)






- 1. Small class sizes encourage discussion and exchange with direct access to instructors and professors.

#### **▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- Credit: Students must complete at least 30 recognized academic credits include 18 required credits (including 12 credits dissertation) and 12 elective credits (including 2 credits of "Research Planning & Design" in Ph.D Program in School of Public Health, and a maximum of 2 credits from other graduate institute).
- 2. Doctoral Subject Examination: Students must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours before they take the doctoral subject examination.
- Qualifying Dissertation Proposal Examination: With the advisor's consent, students
  who pass the subject examination may submit their qualifying dissertation proposal
  application
- 4. Doctoral candidates must meet all of the following requirements in order to proceed with the doctoral dissertation examination:
  - (1) Doctoral candidates must (a). have one first-author original research article

published or accepted by an SCI or SSCI journal with a Journal Impact Factor (JIF) greater than or equal to 2.0 or being ranked above or equal to the 50% JIF Percentile, and (b). have one another first-author original research paper submitted to an SCI or SSCI journal with a submission acknowledgement from the journal prior to proceeding with the doctoral degree examination.

- (2) Publications must be manuscripts coming out of the doctoral dissertation and list the student's affiliation with the GHHS program, and the advisor should be a corresponding author for the two papers. The co-advisor, if any, can be the co-corresponding author.
- (3) Doctoral candidates should orally present one of the publications described above in a peer-reviewed international conference or in an English-speaking conference held in Taiwan.
- 5. Doctoral Degree Examination: Students must pass both the doctoral qualifying examination and the dissertation proposal examination in order to advance to doctoral candidacy.

Qualification: Completion of a master's degree in public health, medicine, or other health sciences or related fields at public or registered private universities and independent colleges, or foreign universities and colleges, approved by the Ministry of Education, ROC (Taiwan).

The International Cooperation and Development Fund (TaiwanICDF) scholarship at Taipei Medical University is only provided for students enrolled at the School of Health Care Administration. Apart from displaying the spirit: helping the weak and befriending with diplomatic allies, the "International Master's Program" is the first English-conducting healthcare administration master's program to develop an English-based learning environment in Taiwan.

The program offers interdisciplinary courses in English. Core courses focus primarily on health care administration, and the program also provides courses in the theory and practice of health insurance, medical informatics, total quality management in healthcare, operations research in healthcare organizations, health information management, international collaborative efforts on injury prevention and control, and writing scientific papers in English

#### ▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor's degree received from or current enrollment as a senior student in universities accredited by Taiwan's Ministry of Education is required.

## Taipei National University of the Arts International Master of the Arts Program in Cultural and Creative Industries (IMCCI)

#### ▲ ABOUT THE PROGRAM

IMCCI program focuses on cultivating professionals in the field of cultural and creative industries, with arts related courses covering "Cultural and Creative Industries Management" and "Aesthetics and Cultural Creative Industries". Through seminars, on-site visits, and internships or thesis, IMCCI cooperates with various academic institutions and industries to incorporate theory and practice, establishing long-term networking for students and alumni around the world.

#### **▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Overseas Academic Credentials
  - All overseas academic credentials have to confirm to relevant regulations by the Ministry of Education (MOE) of R.O.C. Taiwan. At the time of registration/ enrollment at the school, those holding overseas academic credentials have to submit related documents verified by Taiwan overseas representative offices (see Appendix 1). Otherwise, their admission will be annulled.
- 2. Academic Background Requirement-Master's Programs
- 3. Those with bachelor's degree;
- 4. Those who are expecting their bachelor's degree in the current academic year;
- 5. Those with equivalent educational level (to that of Taiwan's academic degree system) for entering master's programs.
- 6. International students, who have been dismissed by from universities/college after admission due to behavior issues, poor academic performances or a conviction under the Criminal Law, are not allowed to apply for admission via this channel. Should any of the above violation cases be verified, the applicant's student status will be revoked immediately.
- 7. An international student submitting forged, fabricated, or altered papers for the purpose of the their school application shall be subject to enrollment qualification

8. In accordance with MOE's regulations regarding the recognition of academic credentials, holders of passing certificate of appraisal of academic achievement examination issued by foreign institutes are not eligible for application in terms of academic background.

#### ▲ HOW TO APPLY

The application packet must be submitted either in person or by express mail to the address indicated below prior to the application deadline (postmarked according to the deadline stated in the most recent Admissions Handbook). International express service such as DHL or FedEx is recommended for application packets mailed from overseas. Office hour: Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

- 1. Make sure that you are eligible to apply as an international student. (Please refer to TNUA Regulations Regarding International Student Admission and MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan)
- 2. Complete on-line application and print out 2 copies. (Signature required)
- 3. Prepare the entry documents and required documents by the departments/graduate institutes, and pay the application fee, NTD 2,000. (Note: Applicants of the International Master of Arts Program in Cultural and Creative Industries (IMCCI) do not have to pay the application fee if they also apply for the ICDF Scholarship.)
- 4. Submit application (hard copy) to the International Exchange Center before April 6. (Any late application will not be processed.).
- 5. Application process is estimated to be open from February to April each year.

- 1. One copy of application form (with one 2-inch bareheaded bust photo).

- 5. Four copies of career plan (describe your personal career plan within five years of graduating from the program).
- 6. Four copies of the highest academic degree or current enrollment certificate (with one original copy). The diploma should be in Chinese or English and verified by the R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy/Consulate/Representative Office in the country the document is issued.
  - (1) Four copies of updated transcript in English (with one official copy). The official copy should be in Chinese or English and verified by the R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy/Consulate/ Representative Office in the country the document is issued.
  - (2) Four copies of master-level English proficiency (with one official copy): the certificate (validity within three years) must be above TOEFL-iBT 79, IELTS 6.5, TOEIC 750, or BULATS 75 (Level 4). Applicants are exempt from this requirement if from countries whose official language is English.
- \* The content of item 3~5 should be expressed only in English. Item 3~8 required four copies of each set of documents. They are to be of A4 size and accordingly bound together.

- 6. One-page autobiography within 300~500 words or curriculum vitae, written in English.
- 7. Proof of financial sufficiency such as a bank statement indicating sufficient funds for staying in Taiwan issued by your financial institution(s). The issuing date should be after January 1, 2019.



- 1. Individuals of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China and does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of application, are qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
- 2. Individuals of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following regulations and who held residency overseas continuously, for no less than 6 years, are also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.



If your transcript is obtained from schools in Taiwan, it is not necessary to be certified by Taiwan Embassy.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation should be submitted online. The notify letter will be sent to referees automatically after applicants complete the application.
- 5. A one-page study plan, written in English.
- 6. One-page autobiography within 300~500 words or curriculum vitae, written in English.
- 7. Proof of financial sufficiency such as a bank statement indicating sufficient funds for staying in Taiwan issued by your financial institution(s). The issuing date should be after January 1, 2019.

8. Copy of the personal information on your passport.

#### ▲ ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The School of Medicine for International Students is a newly established four-year M.D. program (taught in English for Bachelor's degree) in compliance with the government policy that aims to cultivate passionate and devoted international medical professionals for countries that have a diplomatic relationship with Taiwan. Students are conferred only a Bachelor's diploma in English upon graduation and must return to their home countries after graduation, and students are not allowed to take the medical licensing examination or to conduct medical practice in Taiwan.

#### **▲ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Applicants who have a bachelor's degree or above conferred by a local or foreign university recognized by the R.O.C. Ministry of Education may apply for admission; those who have studied at the School of Medicine, Dentistry or Chinese Medicine for four years or more may apply with credentials of an equivalent education level. The original diploma (or academic credentials) verified by the local R.O.C. diplomatic mission must be submitted upon registration and enrollment (if the diploma (or academic credentials) is in a language other than Chinese or English, a Chinese or English translation verified by the local R.O.C. diplomatic mission or a registered translation agency is required); otherwise, an applicant will be considered disqualified and denied admission.
- 2. Pursuant to Paragraph 1 of Article 2 in the MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, applicants who have a foreign nationality, have never had the nationality of the Republic of China\* ("R. O.C."), and do not have an overseas Chinese student status at the time of application may apply for admission.
- 3. Any matter not mentioned herein should be subject to the MOE Program of Assisting Countries with Diplomatic Relations in Cultivating Medical Talents, the MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, and the MOE Regulations Governing the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Records by Institutions of Higher Education.

- 7. Three recommendation letters
- 8. Other supporting documents:
  - (1) The medical school admission exam result (MCAT, BMAT or GAMSAT) within the most recent 3 years
  - (2) Practical experience in health care and laboratories
  - (3) Experience in volunteer service



## Appendix 1: General Eligibility Criteria for TaiwanICDF Scholarship

#### An applicant must:

- Be a citizen of a country on the List of Countries Eligible for TaiwanICDF Scholarship, and satisfy any specific criteria established by his or her country and/or government of citizenship.
- Neither be a national of the Republic of China (Taiwan) nor an overseas compatriot student.
- Satisfy the admission requirements of the partner university to which he or she has applied to study under a TaiwanICDF scholarship.
- Be able to satisfy all requirements for a Resident Visa (Code: FS) set by the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) set by the Ministry of the Interior, of the ROC (Taiwan) government (this means that the TaiwanICDF has the right to revoke a scholarship offered if an applicant cannot satisfy the visa requirements).
- Upon accepting a TaiwanICDF scholarship, not hold any other ROC (Taiwan) government-sponsored scholarship (such as the Taiwan Scholarship) in the same academic year in which the TaiwanICDF scholarship would be due to commence.
- Not be applying for another TaiwanICDF scholarship in unbroken succession
   —to apply for a 2019 scholarship, applicants who have already held a
   TaiwanICDF scholarship, MOFA's Taiwan Scholarship or an MOE scholarship
   must have graduated before July 31, 2018.
- Have never had any scholarship revoked by any ROC (Taiwan) government agency or related institution, nor been expelled from any Taiwanese university.
