Thirty Five (35) students from AUAP member institutions will be selected to participate in the coming AUAP- ZU Scholarships for the Year 2019 (March-First batch and November-batch). Members in good standing of AUAP are encouraged to nominate their candidates (faculty members are included).

 - an Active Member (i.e. has paid membership fees for the year 2019, 2020 and 2021)
 - or new Active Member (4 years membership payment; 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021)

Remarks; New Member can pay the membership fee in Euros and Peso currencies.

2. Each member can nominate 1-2 candidates.
3. Nominating institution must follow the following:

3.1 Research Proposals at least 450-500 words

3.2 Submit an application (attached), photo and brief introduction of each candidate, copy passport, certificate and transcript.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES, TO BE NOMINATED FROM AUAP MEMBER INSTITUTIONS ARE:

1. Holder of a Bachelor degree or Master degree
2. Grade point average must be reasonably high
3. Submit research proposals (450-500 words)
4. Letter of recommendation from AUAP
5. Has good health

The Scholarships cover:

1. Tuition fee
2. Accommodation
3. Salary 3,500 RMB per month for Ph.D. Programme and 3,000 RMB for Master Programme.

Remarks: 1. The scholarship does not cover the air ticket, visa, personal expenses and insurance during their stay.

2. The host (ZU) will arrange the pick up at the Zhengzhou International Airport, Zhengzhou City, China.

DEADLINE: Application form with the cover letter from the President/ Rector/ Vice Chancellor must be sent to AUAP Secretariat on or before March 31, 2018 at 12.00 pm., Bangkok, Thailand Time.

The Secretariat will select the candidates and announce the results on May 31, 2019.. Then, the host will coordinate directly to each candidate for the formal invitation to apply for a visa. The Academic Year starts in early September 2019.

Brief Introduction of ZZU

Founded in 1928, Zhengzhou University is the largest university in China with 46 schools offering 110 bachelor, 256 master and 127 doctor programs for 72,000 students, including 15,000 postgraduate and 1,800 international students, and nine affiliated teaching hospitals with 20,000 beds. The President Scholarship

● Coverage & Duration

The President Scholarship offers full scholarship for doctor candidate, which covers tuition, accommodation, and living allowance. It is renewable upon the annual review result. The duration of scholarship varies from 3 to 4 years according to the duration of the full-time doctor program.



● Program & Medium of Instruction

There are 127 doctor programs in 24 schools of Zhengzhou university sponsored by the scholarship. All programs can be instructed either in Chinese or in English. ● Eligibility

The application will be assessed by Scholarship Committee, and the result will be announced online.

- 1. The Photocopy of Passport (Pages with photo and address).
- 2. The Bachelor and Master Certificate(Certified copy) .
- 3. The Transcripts of Bachelor and Master Study(Issued by the University).
- 4. Two Letters of Recommendation from Professors(Original,with contact information).
- 5. The Research Proposal (No less than 2000 words, include the background, the objectives and the methodology or approach you propose to take in studying the subject matter) .
- 6. The Valid Report of Language Proficiency Tests(Original, valid for two years) .
- 7. The Physical Examination Report (Valid only for six months).
- 8. The Certificate of Non-criminal Record (Valid only for six months).
- 9. Other Documents.
