Eligibility

To be eligible to apply, applicants must meet all the requirements below.

1. Nationality: Non-Korean*

- * To be eligible to apply through this admissions process, applicants and their parents must be nationals (i.e. passport holders) of a country other than Korea,
- * Korean nationals with dual or multiple nationalities are not eligible to apply; this applies to the applicant and both parents.
- * Applicants who have acquired non-Korean nationality after birth are eligible only if the applicant and both parents have acquired the non-Korean nationality prior to the applicant's enrollment in high school(G10).
- * Ewha Womans University accepts applications from female applicants only.
- * Applicants and their parents of Korean origin and applicants who have acquired non-Korean nationality after birth must submit additional documents that verify a) the renunciation of Korean nationality and b) the date of acquisition of the non-Korean nationality.
- * Any document verifying the divorce or death of parent(s)
 - → In the case where an applicant's parents are divorced, the applicant's nationality eligibility is determined by the nationality of the legal guardian (father/mother).

4. Additional Requirements for Graduate Program Applicants

A. Law

Combined Master's and Doctoral Program in Law is only open to applicants with at least 3 years of legal practice experience.

B. Nursing Science

C. Medicine
