

Announcement of Naresuan University on "Continuation of Preventive Measures against Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" Volume Two

With reference to the Announcement of Naresuan University on "Preventive Measures against Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" dated April 30, 2020, which is effective from the date of signing to May 15, 2020 and to further control the outbreak of COVID-19, the university, in line with the Orders and Measures of the Phitsanulok Governor, hereby announces the followings as set forth by Naresuan University Act 1990, section 20:

- 1. Conventional teaching continues to be ceased and the only mode of teaching delivery is to be done online. Operations of the Naresuan University Hospital and the Dental Hospital proceed as usual whereas other back office staff members remain in duty as minimally required as possible during official office hours.
- 2. University staff members are still bound with presently/likely to be announced university announcements, orders and measures implemented by the governor with regard to the pandemic of COVID-19.
- 3. Faculties/Schools/College/Divisions continually and strictly follow preventive measures against COVID-19. Frequent sanitation of office spaces, scientific laboratories, et cetera is advised. This includes cleaning of shared equipment such as computers, microphones, and speakers.
 - Besides, each of the offices prepares/rearranges working environment, focusing on social distancing. Staff members wear masks/face shields, regularly wash hands, or frequently use hand sanitizer gels.

Executive staff members ranging from Deans of Faculties (or equivalent positions) to Directors of Divisions (or equivalent positions) assign staff members who will work from home as deemed necessary.

All units must be ready to fully operate when surveillance period of COVID-19 is lifted.

Faculties/Schools/College/Divisions are to examine if there is any staff member/student who travels from other provinces/countries. If such the case is found, report must be filed to the university and the Phitsanulok province, respectively.

- 4. It is advised that university staff members avoid/reduce engaging in social activities. If found vulnerable to get infected with the disease, immediately follow measures identified by the university and the province to control and prevent the pandemic.
- 5. University staff members are to strictly comply with this announcement. Any issues arisen from the enforcement of this announcement, the decision of the president is final.

Effective from May 16, 2020 to May 31, 2020.
