

Naresuan University Announcement Subject: No Gift Policy for the Fiscal Year 2024

As of December 8, 2020, the Cabinet approved the national reform plan for the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition), leading to significant changes that benefit the public. Article 4, focused on developing the Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and non-profit-oriented, is integral to this reform. Section 1.1 emphasizes, "All government agencies should declare themselves as entities where officials refrain from accepting any form of gifts while performing their duties (No Gift Policy)," demonstrating the commitment to combating corruption and fostering values that uphold morality (Integrity) and honesty in duty.

In light of this, Naresuan University hereby declares a policy of not accepting or providing property, gifts, or any other benefits in the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) for the fiscal year 2024, outlined as follows:

- 1. Naresuan University is an institution where administrators, government officials, employees, and all staff members refrain from accepting gifts or presents of any kind while carrying out their duties.
- 2. Executives, civil servants, employees, and staff members of Naresuan University are explicitly prohibited from seeking or obtaining any form of gifts or presents while performing their duties.
- 3. In instances where it becomes necessary to give or receive gifts in adherence to customs, cultural practices, or manners, such actions should be considered appropriate and must comply with the regulations set forth by the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Receiving Gifts by Government Officials in 2001, as well as the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the criteria for receiving property or other benefits in accordance with the ethical standards for government officials in 2020.

Therefore, this announcement is made for your acknowledgment and strict compliance.
